

NRG July 6th 2026

- 1) Verge - It required some cutting back to stop daisies dominating and to allow other species to flourish. We are very pleased with how well it has grown. We identified 33 species ! In the Autumn we will move many of the daisies to the Tump.
- 2). Tump - The trees are in good health despite the hot weather. We reduced the tree guards to allow the leaves to breathe and gave the trees a good water. We coordinated with the Community Trust to help manage the cutting of the Tump and plan to plant herbaceous plants eg Daisies which should compete with the nettles and the doc. This planting will take place in the Autumn. It's too dry to plant now.
- 3). Church yard - In May we had a working party and decided to lay weed suppressant covering so that we can sow grass seed in the early Autumn. John and Alice from Redgate came along to join us. We have watered the trees a few times. Ongoing discussions re the Bench - and will decide soon.

We are continuing with small working parties as and when to continue to care for the plants in the dry weather. We hope to have a small NRG stall at the Fun Day to be a presence and be there to chat to people about our projects.
